News from the Clubhouse by Marty Clegg, Secy/Treas

The monthly meeting of the Falls City Mustang Club was called to order by President Steve Merritt on 16 August 2017. Steve thanked the unusually large group for attending the meeting. Sec/Treasurer Marty Clegg gave an update of the club finances along with passing out copies to everyone. Frank Hayden, Early Model VP, related an article about a '66 fastback owned by the 4th owner and missing a number of parts. The gentleman restored the Mustang himself and has won five MCA awards in five showings. Brenda Clegg, Membership Chairperson, announced two new memberships, Chad and Cindy Haas of Louisville who own a 2007 GT and Michael and Carolyn Riley also of Louisville who own a '71 Convertible. Frank Hayden, MCA Regional Director, spoke about the upcoming MCA Grand National show at Kansas City. Steve announced several upcoming car shows to include the Utica Save Our School and North Harrison Band show on 19 August. The FCMC monthly cruise-in is this Friday at the Sellersburg McDonald's. August 25-26 is Mustang month at the Somerset Summernites Cruise-in. The Madison River Run show and the Amvets car show is Saturday, September 2. September 10 is the Sportsdrome Speedway show and the Owensboro Mustang Roundup is September 23. The annual We Care show is Sunday September 24 and the Derby City Fordfest is October 14. A number of shows attended by FCMC members were mentioned to include the Hoosier Mustang Summer Slam, a show in Cecila, Ky and a benefit for a slain police officer in Indy attended by Tim and Sam Livingston. On club outings, Steve and Nancy are working to establish a date for their annual club cookout. In new business, Steve outlined the need for a new sound system for use at car shows and cruise-in's. He asked members for approval to seek out the systems available along with prices and actually go ahead with the purchase. He asked Brandon Grant and Rich Cook to assist with the search. Members approved the request to seek out and purchase a new system. In regard to donations, a number of possible charities were brought up to expend the first quarter money. It was decided to donate \$250 to the We Care charity and \$250 to Pets for Vets charity.
