News from the Clubhouse by Marty Clegg, Secy/Treas

The 18 January 2023 meeting of the Falls City Mustang Club was called to order by President Steve Merritt at the New Albany American Legion. Steve welcomed everyone to the first meeting of the new year. Marty Clegg, Sec/Treasurer, reported of the club finances along with distributing a copy of the treasurer's report to everyone. Marty also displayed a card from Shermagne Livingston thanking the FCMC for the memorial gift for Tim. Brenda Clegg, Membership Chairperson, announced one new membership, Tim and Judy Black of Floyds Knobs who own a 1970 Mach 1, 2009 Shelby GT500 KR and a 2012 Boss 302. Kamos Glover, Co-MCA Regional Director, announced the MCA national shows for 2023 beginning with Albuquerque, NM on June 9-11 then Indianapolis on July 27-30 and finally the grand national in Melbourne, FL on September 8-10. Kamos related that discussion is taking place to have a fourth show in October in Topeka, KS. The 60th anniversary show for 2024 is planned for the Barber Motorsports Park near Birmingham, AL. To register for any MCA show you will need to go to Motosho.com. Steve outlined several shows and events for this new year starting with the Ponies in the Smokies. The actual car show is Friday, March 24 but there are events planned for the entire week. There is a possibility the FCMC will host a Mustang Birthday Bash at Jim O'Neal Ford on April 15; details will be forthcoming. August 19 is the Woodward Dream Cruise in Detroit, Michigan. Registration opens May 1 with a maximum of 600 cars permitted in Mustang Alley. Currently a group of FCMC members are planning to attend. The following weekend, August 25-26 is the annual Somernites Cruise in Somerset, KY. As in the past the FCMC has a group of rooms blocked at the Best Western Hotel. Our point of contact is Vickie. The FCMC will start out the new year with bowling at Blackiston Lanes on January 21 at 3pm and again on February 18. Steve thanked everyone who participated in the Angel Tree program on behalf of the FCMC. The club set aside \$1500 for this worthwhile charity. A couple past outings to mention was the Jeffersonville Christmas parade after Thanksgiving where ten club cars joined in the lighted parade. A couple weeks later was the annual FCMC Christmas party. Steve then led a discussion on the annual June car show at Jim O'Neal Ford on June 17 with the pony trail and cruise-in the day before. Steve outlined a few changes being considered along with ideas for the trophies this year. Members are encouraged to seek out sponsors for the car show. The third quarter \$500 donation is now being considered; Steve asked for any suggestions from members.
