## Hoofbeats . . . . .

*News from the Clubhouse by Marty Clegg, Secy/Treas*

The 19 July 2023 meeting of the Falls City Mustang Club was called to order by President Steve Merritt at the New Albany American Legion. Steve welcomed everyone to the meeting. Marty Clegg, Sec/Treasurer, reported on the club finances along with distributing a copy of the treasurer's report to everyone. Marty also noted the anticipated expenses listed for the upcoming budget year along with planned donation amounts. Kamos Glover, Road Boss, spoke about the planned drive to Somerset on August 25 to attend the Somernites Cruise. He asked members their choice of lunch stops in Liberty, Ky. Most favored the Bread of Life Buffet Restaurant. Kamos, Co-MCA Regional Director, also talked about the upcoming Indy MCA show along with MCA shows scheduled for 2024 and 2025.
