

60 YEARS OF MUSTANG APRIL 17TH, 2024

The 2025 Ford Mustang GTD just debuted as a limited-run, roadlegal version of the GT3 race car. Plus, it comes with technology like an adaptive suspension and active aerodynamics that are banned under the competition regulations. It will go on sale in late 2024 or early 2025 at a starting price of around \$300,000. The company will accept buyers only by application in a process similar

to the sales method for the Ford GT.
