News from the Clubhouse by Marty Clegg, Secy/Treas

The 8 May 2024 meeting of the Falls City Mustang Club was called to order by President Steve Merritt at the New Albany American Legion. Steve welcomed everyone to the meeting. Marty Clegg, Sec/Treasurer, reported on the club finances along with distributing a copy of the treasurer's report to everyone. In the absence of Scott McGloshen and Chris Moorman, the Mustang News and Stuff guys, Marty related that there are only two towns in the US named Mustang but no counties. Sheridan, Kansas has the highest number of Mustangs per capita in the US, one Mustang per 202 people. On other Ford trivia, Steve told of Henry Ford's interest in manufacturing charcoal from unused wood used in the manufacture of the Model A. This led to the Kingsford Charcoal Company. Kamos Glover, Road Boss, is working with Kevin and Susie to setup the Friday pony trail prior to the June 15 car show. Brenda Clegg, Membership Chairperson, announced one new membership, Steve and Amy Smith of New Albany who own a 2017 Lighting Blue Mustang GT.
