The 18 March 2026 meeting of the Falls City Mustang Club was called to order by President Kevin Liebert at the New Albany American Legion. Kevin welcomed everyone to the meeting. Marty Clegg, Sec/Treasurer, reported on the club finances along with distributing a copy of the treasurer's report to everyone. Brenda Clegg, Membership Chairperson, announced three new memberships, Brian and Katie Scalf of Charlestown who own a 2019 Mustang GT and a 2020 Mustang GT Premium, James and Jennifer Avery of Jeffersonville who own a 2024 Mustang GT-PP and Steve and Laurie Padilla of Floyds Knobs who own a 2017 Mustang Shelby GT350. May 23 is the Rumble on the River show at Madison. Steve Merritt then discussed various topics relating to the annual June car show including soliciting sponsors, making and distributing show flyers. The monthly cash drawing was won by Kamos Glover. Dining prior to the April meeting will be at Lee's Chicken, located across the street from the American Legion. Being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
