Ford Mustang Owners Barely Drive Their Cars, New Study Shows:

The analysis, which looked at odometer readings from more than 2.1 million three-year-old cars sold in 2025 to calculate the average annual miles driven by drivetrain and model, has found the Ford Mustang to be the least driven gas vehicle. Mustangs owners typically drive just 2,092 miles a year.

Ford Wants To 'Expand' The Mustang Family

The automaker is preparing to launch several new models with starting prices under \$40,000. One of those should be a new sedan. What kind of sedan remains a mystery, but one Ford executive might have just hinted at what's to come, and it might take the form of a four-door Mustang.

Ford CEO Jim Farley was confident that the automaker could make a Mustang with different body forms, like a four-door, "as long as these models have all the performance and attitude of the original."

A report surfaced that alleged Ford showed dealers a Mustang sedan called the Mach-4 alongside an unnamed, safari-like off-road variant of the vehicle.

Current Ford Mustang Recalls:

2026 Mustang: Certain vehicles may have engine piston circlips incorrectly installed, which can lead to piston failure and loss of drive power. Dealers will inspect and replace engines as necessary. Owner notifications began April 10, 2026, under recall number 26S23

2025 Mustang: The exhaust gas recirculation (EGR) valve may fail, causing unexpected loss of drive power. The remedy is under development, with interim notifications sent March 20, 2026, under recall number 26S10

2015–2017 Mustang: Front seat belt anchor pretensioner cables may corrode due to water and road salt, potentially preventing proper restraint during a crash. Dealers will inspect and replace affected assemblies free of charge
