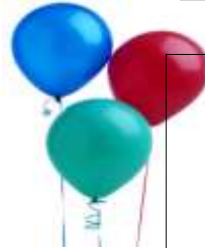

Report: Ford Is Working on a Four-Door Mustang That's Due by 2029

At a dealer event recently, Ford showed an early prototype of a Mustang sedan that would have four doors, hit 60 mph in under 4 seconds, and cost under \$40,000, according to reports from the Wall Street Journal and Automotive News. Though a name hasn't been confirmed, Ford has reportedly been calling it the Mach 4, which would align with a trademark filed in early 2025.

It looks like that future may be closer than anticipated, though there's still plenty of time for the project to get scrapped or altered. The reports say the sedan is expected to go on sale in 2028 or 2029. Two sources told the *WSJ* that the sedan would feature a hybrid powertrain, and one mentioned a hybrid V-8 engine. Attendees at the dealer event told *AN* that the prototype was roughly the same size and shape as the Porsche Panamera, and executives reportedly said it would have more rear legroom than the Panamera.

Ford Mustang Beats All Sporty Car Rivals In 2026 U.S. APEAL Study

Ford Mustang ranked as the top choice in the sporty car segment of the 2026 U.S. APEAL Study, beating out the Mini Cooper. It's the second straight year the Mustang has ranked first among all sporty cars in this study as well.

The national study surveys new-vehicle owners after 90 days of ownership to measure their emotional bond and excitement levels regarding design, comfort, and driving performance.

This Ford Mustang Dark Horse SC Brings the Same 795 HP Goodness — It's Just a Convertible

Ford says the Dark Horse SC convertible will be available next spring, with orders opening up in the next few weeks. It's not clear exactly how much it'll cost yet, but other convertible Mustang variants cost about \$5,000 more than their coupe counterparts. Barring any year-to-year price bumps for the whole Mustang lineup, that means you could see a sticker price around \$113,075.
